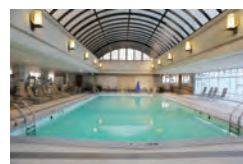

Program Details

1. The 8-day program price includes 8 days of instruction, 9 nights of hotel accommodation, and 2 meals a day.

SAT 2100: \$3,450 / 21,200 RMB

SAT 2400: \$4,250 / 26,100 RMB

ACT: \$3,450 / 21,200 RMB

Early Bird Discount: Paid before Sept. 30, get \$200 (1,200 RMB) off for 8 days, \$100 off for 7 days.

2. Extenuating circumstances may allow students to register for less than 8 days but prior permission must be obtained.
3. Classes are taught in the Sheraton Hotel - the same location as the hotel where students live.
4. Students may arrive one day earlier (Nov. 21) with chaperones, but must register early with Global Study Connections secure a hotel room in advance.
